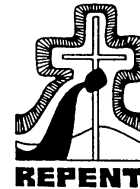
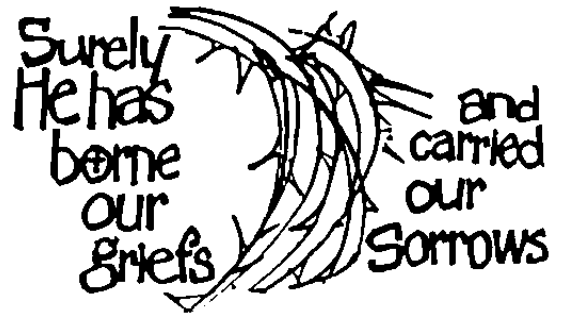

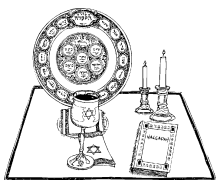

TRIDUUM

THE END - AND THE BEGINNING

The Triduum, three days that come at the end of Lent, commemorates the central events in the Paschal Mystery of Redemption. Culminating in the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter, the Triduum celebrates the new life we have been given through baptism.

DAY ONE: The Last Supper to the Sacrifice of Calvary (No Daily Mass - 9 a.m. Morning Prayer)

After the fasting of Lent, **HOLY THURSDAY** recalls both the Last Supper and the Washing of the Feet, the nourishment for service. **CONFESSIONS ARE AT 8 A.M. AND MASS IS AT 7:00 P.M.**

The sacrifice of **GOOD FRIDAY** is filled with prayer, from Jesus in the Garden to his final words on the Cross. **CONFESSIONS ARE AT 11 A.M., THE PASSION IS AT 3 P.M. IN ENGLISH & 7:00 P.M. BILINGUAL.**

DAY TWO: The Silence of the Tomb (No Daily Mass - 9 a.m. Morning Prayer)

Joseph of Arimathea's charitable gift of the tomb provided a place for the body of Jesus when it was taken down from the Cross. **HOLY SATURDAY** is the day of the hidden mystery of divine action. The disciples were convinced that all their hopes had ended in disaster. Holy Saturday reminds us that our best guess about the future is only that; God has plans and powers beyond anything we can imagine. **VIGIL MASS AT 8 P.M. BILINGUAL.**

DAY THREE: Cooperating with Grace

EASTER morning began with a very human gesture: the women's desire to give Jesus a proper burial. Because they acted on their heartfelt inclination, the Good News of the Resurrection became known to the disciples. The Gospel message is spread whenever we cooperate with God's grace.

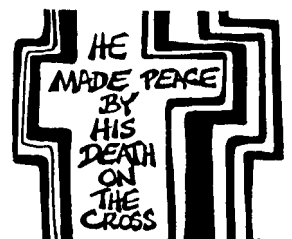

TALKING WITH CHILDREN ABOUT JESUS' DEATH



THE SEASON OF LENT AND EASTER can pose some challenges to Catholic parents who wonder how much they should say to their children about Jesus' death. What do they understand, and how much is too much when discussing Jesus' suffering and death?

Death is an abstract concept, and children are concrete thinkers, so kids are often not fully able to comprehend death until the teenage years, when they begin to think more hypothetically and are able to deal with the abstract more capably. However, there are some concrete aspects to death, which children sometimes



experience in the loss of a pet or perhaps even a family member. For example, they formerly saw and spent time with the lost pet or family member, and now they do not. They might see the lifeless body of a pet or family member and notice that death looks like sleep, and this might lead them to imagine that death is like a sleep from which one doesn't wake up. This can be a scary thought for some children, who don't want to go to sleep for fear they themselves won't awaken.

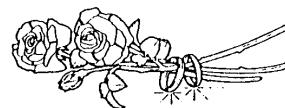

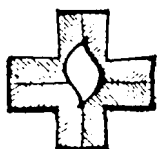
